Borrowing equipment can help you select the best option before purchasing your own equipment. It also fills the gap during temporary periods of need.



## What kind of equipment is available?

MILC has a variety of medical equipment to take out on loan!

Loan equipment includes:

- canes & crutches
  - walkers
  - bedside commodes
  - raised toilet seats
  - shower chairs
  - bath transfer chairs
  - wheelchairs
  - hoist lift
  - assistive technology
  - other small medical items
- are sometimes donated and available.

*Some of these items may not always be available.*

## How do I borrow equipment?

All you need to do is contact us and fill out a simple form.

MILC's Equipment Loan Closet is free of charge for people with a disability and there are no eligibility requirements.

We may also be able to deliver.



Typically, items are loaned out for 30 days at a time, depending on the circumstances of the individual requesting the item.

We will thoroughly discuss this with you to see how we can accommodate you fully.
