NY Connects *free, unbiased information & options counseling on long term services and supports for children or adults with disabilities, family members, caregivers, friends/neighbors, and professionals. (St. Lawrence County Only*)*

Youth Transition Services *Provides guidance and advocacy to help youth successfully transition from high school to college, employment, or independent living. Supports parents as they prepare for and attend IEP/504 meetings.*
